NOMAD ALERT SERVICE BULLETIN ANNO-61-4, 9TH AUGUST, 1978

- 1. SUBJECT PROPELLERS REMOVAL OF GREASE NIPPLE COVERS.
- 2. APPLICABILITY ALL NOMAD N22, N22B, N24 AND N24A AIRCRAFT.
- 3. COMPLIANCE WITHIN 50 FLYING HOURS OR AT NEXT 100 HOURLY INSPECTION WHICHEVER IS THE SOONER.
- 4. REASON IT HAS BEEN FOUND THAT EVEN THOUGH THESE RUBBER COVERS ARE WIRE LOCKED AT THE NIPPLE WAIST, AFTER A PERIOD OF USE THE RUBBER DEFORMS TO SUCH AN EXTENT THAT THE COVER CAN READILY SLIP OFF THE NIPPLE AND POSSIBLY FIND IT'S WAY INTO THE ENGINE INTAKE.
- 5. ACCOMPLISHMENT INSTRUCTIONS
- A. REMOVE SPINNER FROM EACH PROPELLER.
- B. BEHIND EACH SPINNER ARE 6 OFF, (2 EACH BLADE HUB) GREASE NIPPLES EACH FITTED WITH A WIRED RUBBER COVER.
- C. REMOVE COVERS AND DISCARD.
  - NB. OPERATORS ARE TO ENSURE GREASE NIPPLE IS CLEANED PRIOR TO ANY SUBSEQUENT APPLICATION OF GREASE THROUGH UNCOVERED NIPPLE FITTINGS.
- D. REPLACE PROPELLER SPINNERS.
- 6. RECORDING ACTION RECORD COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SERVICE BULLETIN IN THE AIRCRAFT LOG BOOK.
